
Intensive training workshop: "Entrepreneurship" 6 - 7 - 8 October 2020

- Case Study II: COdesign19

CoDedsign19 is a project born from the initiative called "#ActionWeekforCOVID19: Social innovation solutions for the intellectually disabled community", a Social Innovation Hackathon born within ALMALABOR, in collaboration with Learning by Helping, a Spanish Social Innovation Lab. The entire activity was held during the lockdown in Italy, in April 2020. The request for solutions came from the Local government. After 5 days of daily online classes, several hours of student teamwork and daily mentoring sessions, 4 teams of students developed innovative solutions.
